NURS FPX 4025 Assessment 1 ➤ challenges students to critically evaluate a scholarly nursing research article. You'll examine research design, sample validity, ethical considerations, and applicability to clinical settings. The objective is to sharpen your ability to discern and interpret evidence that influences patient care decisions.

NURS FPX 4025 Assessment 3 – Application of Evidence-Based Interventions

NURS FPX 4025 Assessment 3 ➤ requires the development of an evidence-based intervention plan tailored to a clinical issue. Students must demonstrate their ability to align research findings with clinical goals, propose feasible interventions, and explain how implementation would improve patient outcomes and safety.

NURS FPX 4025 Assessment 4 – Communicating Evidence-Based Innovation

NURS FPX 4025 Assessment 4 ➤ concludes the course by assessing students' ability to synthesize and present evidence-based proposals effectively. Whether through presentation slides, a written summary, or an executive report, the focus is on clear articulation of research, rationale for change, and strategies for clinical adoption.
